I have been a resident of the area formerly known as Gwydirville for over 30 years and it is my intention to continue residing in this area.

I have been a single parent, raised my children, paid off my home and am now debt free. For this reason, although I have worked continuously, I do not have considerable savings nor a large superannuation fund. At the age of almost 63 I feel I am not in a position, nor would I desire to borrow money to purchase another house. I also believe I would find it difficult to obtain a loan as I am only 4 years from retirement age.

My home is my most important asset and now that mine and the other residences in this area are within the SAP, the dwellings have become effectively worthless as they will be unsaleable due to the changes in land use and zoning.

I feel very safe living in this area as I live alone. I would not feel this same security should I be forced to move to Moree. Due to the high demand for rentals in Moree at present, if the residents of Gwydirville are required to move, we could find ourselves having to take rentals in a less favourable area of the town. Without borrowing, I would be unable to purchase a new home making renting my only option. This would cause extreme anxiety.
