

What is the Free Tree Giveaway?

From June to October 2021 (inclusive), the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment has partnered with Bunnings Warehouse to provide up to 26,500 trees to 10,500 eligible households across Greater Sydney.

Why is the Government giving away Free Trees?

The Free Tree Giveaway program is part of the Greening our City Premier's Priority, which aims to plant one million trees in Greater Sydney by 2022.

Planting one million trees will provide more shade, cleaner air and more beautiful places to live. To reach the one million trees target we need individuals like you to play a part and plant trees in your own backyard.

Am I eligible for a free tree(s)?

You are eligible if you answer yes to all of the following:

- you have an address in one of the 33 local government areas (LGAs) in Greater Sydney
- you have not applied for a free tree(s) in 2021.

What local government areas are eligible?

Are there any limits on the Free Tree Giveaway?

Yes, including:

- a limited number of trees are available every month from June to October (inclusive).
- only one order per household in 2021 (subject to change)
- once you have been contacted to inform you that your tree(s) are ready, the tree(s) must be collected within 7 days.

What trees can I order?

From June to October 2021, residents will be able to order privacy, shade, flowering and fruit trees. Households should check the [department's website](#) each month to see what trees are on offer.

How many trees can I order?

Households will be able to claim up to 3 x 200mm trees or a citrus tree, depending on what species are available each month.

How do I order my free tree(s)?

Free trees can be claimed via the department's website at: planningportal.nsw.gov.au/Free-Tree. You can log in with your MyServiceNSW details or create a new Planning Portal Account. Follow the instructions to select your tree(s) and submit your application.

Where can I pick up my tree(s) from?

Trees can be collected from your local Bunnings store. After you've submitted your application, Bunnings will let you know when your tree(s) are ready to be picked up (within 15 working days).

What do I do if I get the message "your property is not eligible for a Free Tree" but I live in one of the 33 Greater Sydney LGAs?

Please note that you must select your address from the drop-down list. We suggest that you start by typing your street name and select your address once it appears. If you type out your entire address (instead of selecting from the drop-down list), you will see the message 'Your property is not eligible for a Free Tree'. If you've selected your address from the drop-down list and have an eligible address, but still see this error, please email Admin_FreeTrees@dpie.nsw.gov.au

Who do I contact if I am having trouble applying?

I ordered a Free Tree in 2020, can I order another tree this year?

Yes. We hope your tree (s) are growing and providing you enjoyment and we are keen to support you again in 2021.

What if I miss out in a given month?

You can either check the website at the beginning of each month when more orders will be available or, once all monthly orders are fulfilled, register your interest on the website via a webform. People who register will be notified on the day the giveaway reopens.

Do I need to register my Free Tree(s) for it to count towards the one million tree target?

No, because we are running the Giveaway to support the Greening our City Premier's Priority to plant one million trees by 2022, we will register your free tree(s) on your behalf. For all other trees you plant outside the giveaway, please register them at: dpie.nsw.gov.au/register-your-tree to make it count.
