Subject: Public exhibition – amendment to State Environmental Planning Policy (Industry and Employment) 2021 – Upgrade to Abbotts and Aldington Road in the Mamre Road Precinct

I am writing to inform you that changes to the *State Environmental Planning Policy (Industry and Employment) 2021* are being placed on public exhibition. The exhibition period will run for a period of 28 days from 22 February to 21 March 2024.

The Explanation of Intended Effect outlines the proposed changes and includes:

- The widening of Abbotts Road and Aldington Road to accommodate its status as a Distributor Industrial Road under the Mamre Road Precinct Development Control Plan.
- The rezoning of Abbotts Road to SP2 Infrastructure, marked as "Local Road" and Aldington Road to either SP2 Infrastructure, marked as "Local Road" or SP2 Infrastructure, marked as "Classified Road".
- The realignment of a portion of Aldington Road towards its intersection with the future Southern Link Road.
- Identifying Penrith City Council as the acquisition authority for the SP2 Infrastructure, marked as "Local Road" portion and Transport for NSW as the acquisition authority for the SP2 Infrastructure, marked as "Classified Road" portion.

To enable these road widening works, your property has been identified for partial acquisition.
