Description of development

Installation of two 39.68m² digital advertising signs proposed at the eastern and western elevation of the existing railway overpass bridge at Help Street, Chatswood and associated works.

The application is integrated development requiring concurrence from Transport for NSW (Roads and Maritime Services) under Section 138 of the *Roads Act 1993*, due to the erection of the signs over a public road, being Help Street.
