**Comments on Development Application (DA 10642) New Digital Advertising Sign – Railway Overpass Above the Eastern Distributor, Woolloomooloo**

Thank you for your referral dated 18 February 2021 inviting comment from the Heritage Council of NSW on the above Designated Development proposal.

It is noted that Heritage NSW (HNSW) has not provided comment on this application previously, however, as part of this assessment, a review of the documentation contained in the original Development Application, Notice of Exhibition, Agency Submissions and the Response to Submissions report has been undertaken.

The new digital signage (4m x 13m) is proposed to be affixed to the northern side of the Woolloomooloo Viaduct over the M1. The Woolloomooloo Viaduct is listed on the Transport for NSW s170 Heritage and Conservation Register. The works are also located the vicinity of several locally listed heritage items as well as the following State Heritage Register Items:

- *Royal Botanic Gardens and Domain (SHR 01070)*
- *Woolloomooloo Finger Wharf (SHR 01437)*
- *The Gunnery (SHR 00927)*
- *St Peter's Church and Precinct (SHR 00148)*
- *Sydney Harbour Naval Precinct (SHR 01705)*
- *Juanita Nielsen's House (SHR 01929)*

Our review of the documentation indicates that while the above SHR items are located in the vicinity of the proposal, they are at substantial distances from the project area (Royal Botanical Gardens and Domain at 120m and all other listings located more than 290m) and do not have any significant view lines to the proposed signage.

Thus, it is considered that the comments from Heritage NSW related to the above SHR listed items are not required.

It is recommended, however, that comments provided by The City of Sydney Council related to impacts upon locally listed heritage items in the vicinity of the proposal should be further deliberated.
