Over the past 12 years, development in St Leonards has proceeded at an unprecedented pace, with little coordination nor regard for amenities essential to residents: parklands, sportsgrounds and open space, public transportation, education, traffic, pedestrians and schools.

There is already a three x two street block of land where population density is being increased by more than 10x due to radical re-zoning and developer deals (South St Leonards precinct). Anybody on or around Pacific Highway has been subjected to sometimes dangerous winds from wind-tunnel effect of all the new highrises, and there is precious little greenery, with zero plans for more. It is totally unacceptable and irresponsible to add further residential highrises to the area without providing real, spacious and useful open space, as well as wider pavements
