Introduction

• The previous agenda items were discussed and confirmed as complete.

Program updates

- The MOG changes were discussed. Agencies were asked to advise the team if they require a
 name change for the Concurrence and Referral service because of the MOG changes. The
 requests should be submitted via the customer support team, and they will be actioned
 accordingly.
- The NSW Planning Portal roadmap and the types of releases was discussed. The roadmap can be viewed at https://www.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/roadmap-nsw-planning-portal.
- The roadmap is updated monthly.

Release updates

- The recent and upcoming NSW Planning Portal releases, including the Farming pre-assessment tool developed in conjunction with the Department of Primary Industries, were discussed.
- The reference group was provided with an update on the chatbot functionality. It is currently being tested internally prior to its release in June 2024.
- Question on notice: Transport NSW had a number of support items that have been blocked due to technical issues and as a result the related response was overdue. This impacts the statistics for the Agency. Once the technical issue is resolved, does the department backdate the statistics so that the Agency reporting isn't negatively impacted?

Customer service update

- The levels of customer support for the program were outlined for attendees, including how to escalate a P ticket.
- An update was provided on the actions the Department has taken to reduce the backlog of customer support tickets.
