

# **Revise a BASIX Certificate**

A BASIX certificate may be revised after issuance by the original creator of the certificate.

Please note that any amendments made to a BASIX certificate may affect the ability of your project to achieve the mandatory BASIX targets.

Revising the certificate will copy over all the original information into a new version for you to carry out the amendments.

Follow the steps below to revise a BASIX certificate in the NSW Planning Portal.

### Locate application
