


Requesting operational consent for a deferred commencement Development Application

When a development application with a deferred commencement condition is approved through the NSW Planning Portal, the applicant is required to submit a request for operational consent to the consent authority within the specified period before the development consent can become operational.

This guide provides instructions on how to request for operational consent via the NSW Planning Portal.


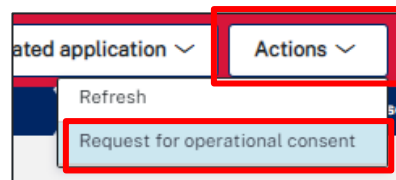
Requesting operational consent

1. Log in to the NSW Planning Portal. **Locate** and **open** the relevant application in your Completed Work. Note: the application will have a status of “Deferred commencement”.

2. **Select** Request for operational consent from the Actions dropdown menu.




