

How to submit the expected completion amendment notice

After submitting the Intent to Seek Occupation Certificate (ITSOC) case, the expected completion notice date can be amended at any time via the expected completion amendment notice option on the actions menu. If you intend to apply for an occupation certificate within _/+60 days of the original expected completion notice date than there is no need to submit an amendment.

The building work levy may be re-calculated due to CPI changes, however there is no requirement to redo the strata building bond section.

To submit an amendment to the ECN, follow the below steps.

1. Click on the ITSOC case reference number.	> Development overview > Construction certificates > Building works - Occupation certificates ITSOC case reference Developer ITSOC case status ITSOC-2023-1850 ADAM FRENCH ECN submitted	
2. Click actions, then click expected completion amendment notice.	Refresh Expected completion amendment notice Withdraw ITSOC
