**To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative  
Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled.**

The Petition of the residents of South Western Sydney in and around the Suburbs of  
Liverpool, Campbelltown and Camden – Within and around the State electorates of  
Macquarie Fields, Campbelltown, Camden, Liverpool and Holsworthy.

Brings to the attention of the House the Notice to residents of Edmondson Park from the  
Planning and Environment Department advising that the number of dwellings increase from  
440 to 3286 on Application number MP 10\_0118MOD 5 which the residents consider to be  
OVERDEVELOPMENT of the area. And the residents also bring to attention the time limit  
given from the 7<sup>th</sup> November to 4<sup>th</sup> December 2018 is very close to the Christmas / New Year  
Holidays and the closure of Parliament until after the Election in March 2019.

The undersigned petitioners therefore ask the Legislative Assembly to provide an extension  
to the period for consideration of this matter until 60 days after the State Election. And to  
also ask that the Government to construct the necessary infrastructure including Roads and  
Commuter Car Parking as a matter of urgency to cater for existing demand let alone the  
future demand that this increase in population will place on the Community.
