Description of development consent

The development application (DA 9876) was approved on 31 March 2022 by the Land and Environment Court. The Penrith Lakes Employment Lands subdivision and construction approved works comprising:

- Torrens title subdivision of three lots into four environmental lots and one residual lot;
- subdivision of the residual lot into 93 Community title lots and one community association lot;
- thirteen (13) development stages;
- earthworks to achieve the final site levels and landscaping works;
- construction of internal roads, including a slip lane to Old Castlereagh Road, footpaths and shared pathways and infrastructure to be dedicated to Council; and
- freestanding advertisement signage.

Description of proposed modification

The modification application seeks to delete the requirement for a left turn deceleration lane at the intersection of Castlereagh Road and Lugard Street. No other changes to roadworks are proposed.

About the exhibition

An exhibition process allows any individual or organisation to have their say about a proposed development.

The applicant of DA9876 has made a request to the Land and Environment Court to modify DA9876 pursuant to s4.55(8) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979. The Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure (the department) is notifying the modification on behalf of the Court.
