- 1. Landscaping plans
 - o In response to Council's concern Item g the design has been amended to incorporate:
 - A planting buffer on the northern, eastern and southern boundaries of Lot 429.
 - Grassed area over the majority of the site
 - The revised design is detailed on newly prepared Landscaping drawings, L00, L01, L02 and L03 prepared by Taylor Brammer.
- 2. Revised Civil Engineering plans by JN dated 29/11/2021 and 9/12/2021.
 - Plans C001, C002, C010, C011, C100, C101, C102, C103, C200, C201, C202, C203, C204 C205 and
 C300 have been revised and additional plan C301 created to incorporate the following changes:
 - Landscaping and topsoil incorporated into the design to address Council's concerns and align with the design provided by Taylor Brammer (refer to 1 above).
 - Gravel protection to capping layer replaced over most of the site with topsoil and grass.
 - Clay capping on the northern, eastern and southern boundaries replaced with topsoil and planting with a root barrier below.
 - o Traffic plans, C400 and C401 revised to reflect the revised traffic management plan (item 3 below).
- 3. Revised Construction Traffic Management Plan
 - In response to council's concerns Item H the traffic management plan has been revised avoid heavy vehicles on the residential streets.

 - o BDAR has been updated to include survey of the Green and Yellow Bell frog.
- 5. Remediation Cap Report
 - Additional report provided by Reditus, confirming adequacy of the revised capping layer details shown on JN drawings (refer to item 2 above).
